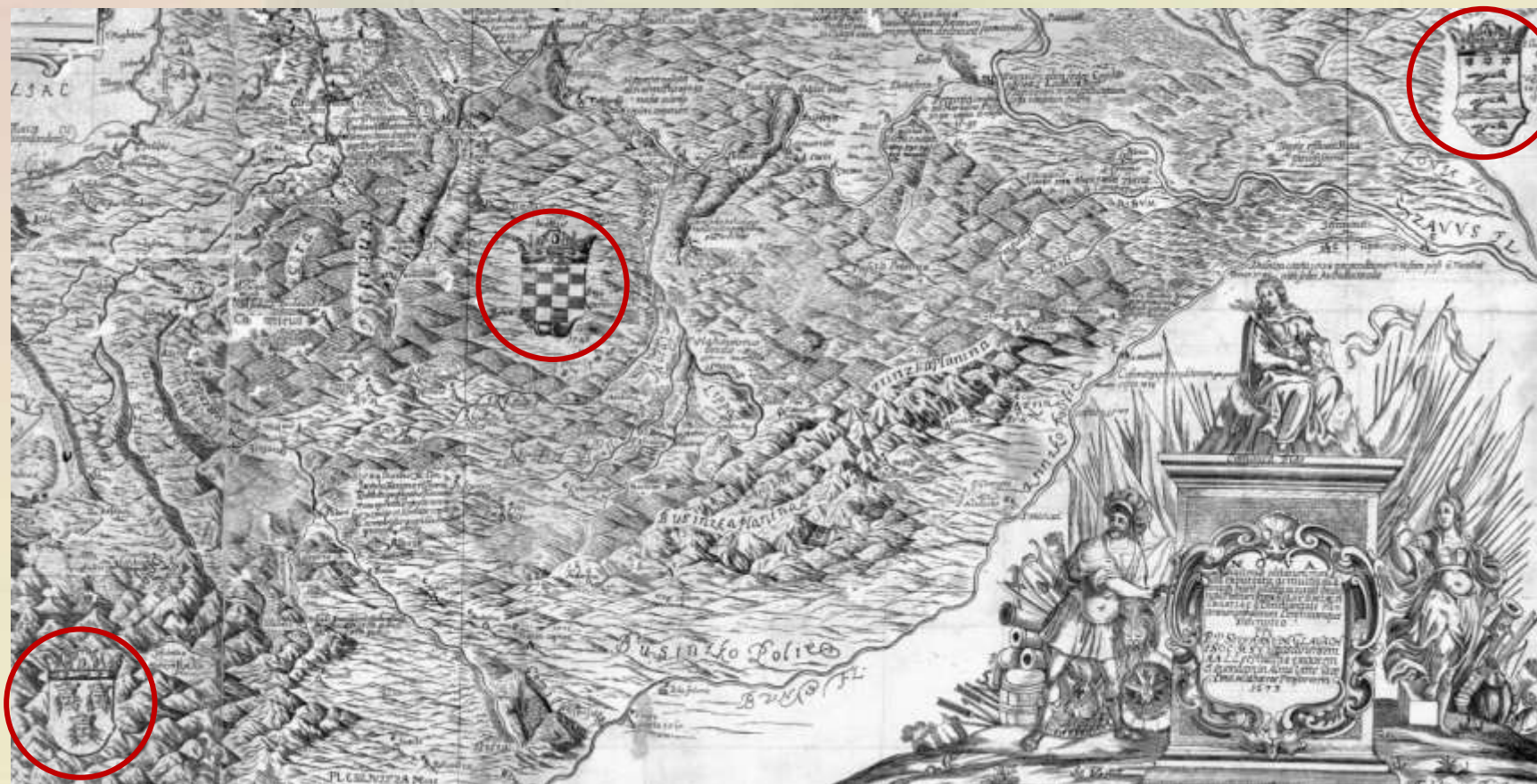
Map scales



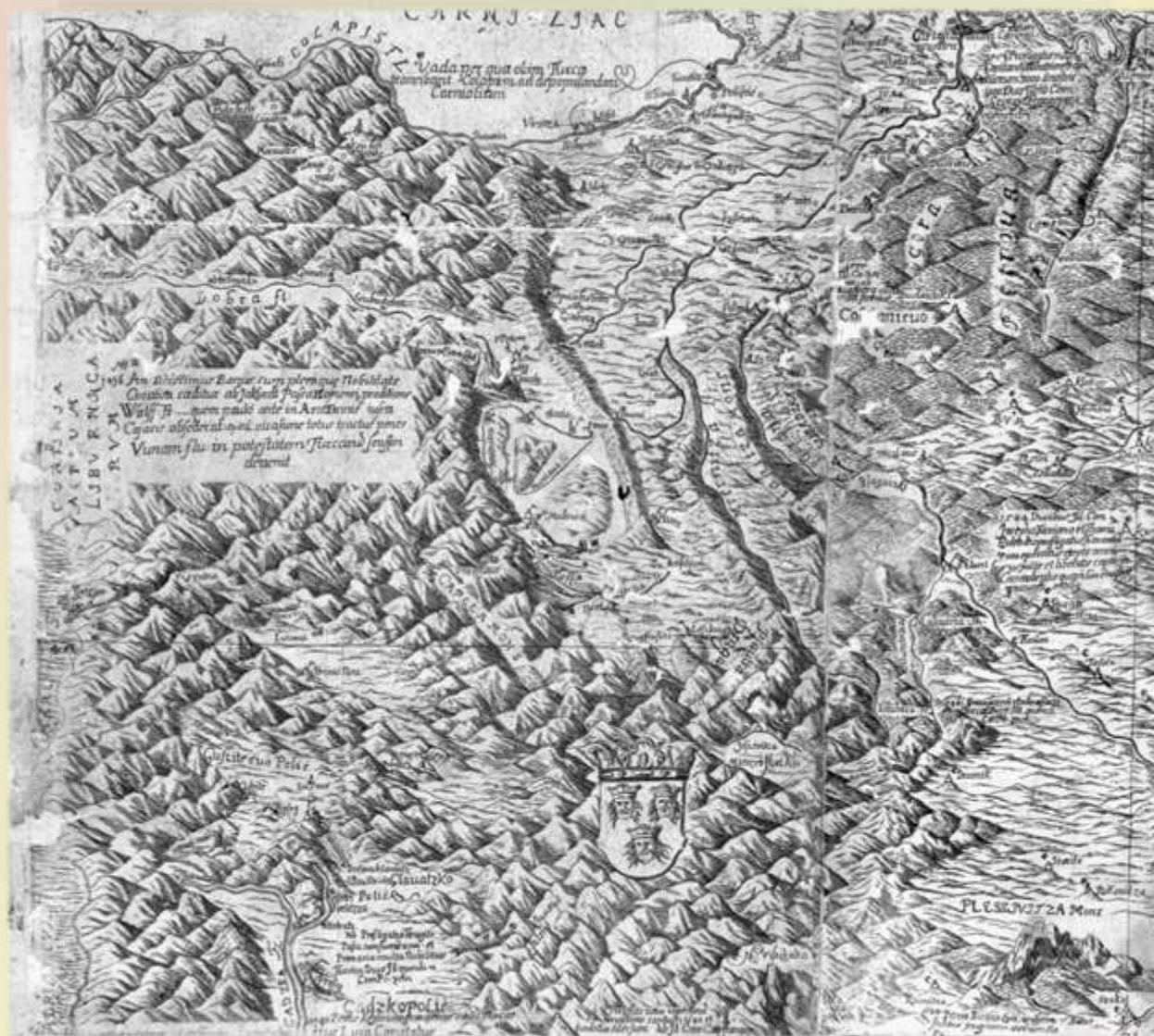
Legend for settlements



Four world cardinal directions



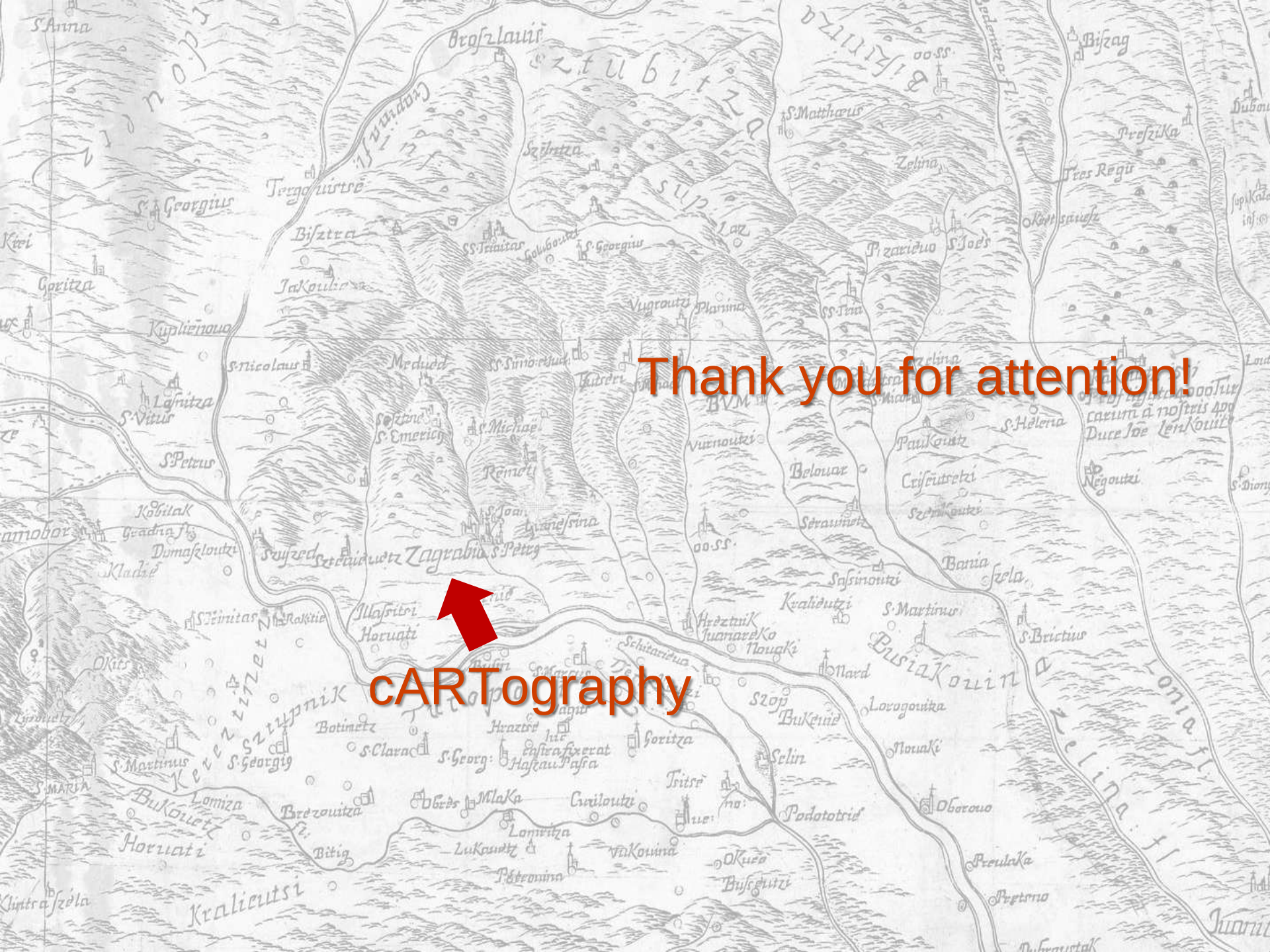
Coats of arms of Croatian regions
